2	in support of my petition for a protection order and an order to surrender/weapons.	
3	This is an accordant to able in a part of	
4	This is my second attempt in obtain a protection order against the respondent. The first one was	
5	denied as I did not disclose my dissolution case in Yakima, WA that was finalized in 2023. It was	
6	also denied as the only evidence I produced was a newspaper clipping. Due to the respondent's	
7	recent charges and other disclosures made by our children, I felt it was appropriate to try again.	
8	I want to make the court aware that I will be filing a Petition to Modify a Final Parenting Plan/Child	
9	Support Order in Benton County, WA. Both parties have lived in Benton County for over 3 years	
10	with the children. I am waiting on the certified copy of the final orders from the courts in Yakima,	
11	WA.	
12	The respondent and I were married 09/04/2014. We split on 12/08/2020. The respondent and I	
13		
14	were divorced on 04/07/2023. The respondent and I have two children together. They are 8 and 5	
15	years old.	
16	During our divorce proceedings, the respondent claimed to be single. New information contradicts	
17	the respondent's statements. The respondent was keeping his girlfriend a secret due to her age	
18	and previous encounters.	
19	The respondent's girlfriend is currently 17 years old and lives in the same household. They have a	
20		
21	10-month-old son who was born on 04/08/2023. Due to the ages, the girlfriend got pregnant at 15	
22	years old.	
23	According to the police report/affidavit, on 02/03/2024, the respondent and his girlfriend were	
24	drinking at their home with one of the girlfriends' friends. The girlfriend's friend felt ill from drinking

They both ended up falling asleep. The girlfriend woke up to see the respondent's face down by her friend's private area. The respondent and the 16-year-old female both had their pants down. The 16-year-old was passed out. The respondent then moved towards the 16-year old's chest as if he was getting on top of her to have intercourse. The 16-year-old woke up to find the respondent on top of her. The girlfriend tried to confront the respondent. The respondent ended up walking out of the room like nothing happened. Both minor females got up, grabbed the 10-month-old child, and left in the respondent's truck to find help. The respondent ended up taking his girlfriends car and chasing after them. The minor females flagged down an officer. The respondent drove off after.

The police went to the respondents' home to arrest him. However, the respondent would not come out. After 3 hours, the police forcefully entered the home. The respondent was arrested on 02/03/2024. He made bail on 02/05/2024.

After seeing the police report with the minors' names, I realized the respondent's girlfriend is the same girl that had allegations against the respondent when she was 11. The respondent worked as an SRO at Washington Middle School in Yakima, WA. During his time there, a different female student posted on Snapchat about an inappropriate relationship was happening between an 11-year-old girl and the respondent. The respondent turned things around and said the 11-year-old girl was obsessed with him. An investigation was conducted but no charges were made.

Since the respondent's arrest on 02/03/2024, our son has made some disclosures to me. Our 8-year-old son has stated that the respondent is violent. The incidents include loud yelling, punching a TV, & slapping the 17-year-olds hand. The respondent has also hit/smacked our children which goes against our Final Parenting Plan. It was also disclosed by the girlfriend to my

son, which was confirmed to police, that the respondent has hit her in the face.

Other disclosures by our son were that the respondent and his 17-year-old girlfriend have intercourse when our sons are present. These incidents have taken place in the pool with our children in as well, on the couch in the living room, in a hotel room on a trip with the children in the same room, and in the bedrooms with the door open. Our sons were left to take care of the 10-month-old infant while some of these incidents took place. The following are some examples of the incidents and when they occurred.

In June of 2023, our son stated he kept hearing the respondent and "Jelly" making loud moaning noises. He also said that he went to the respondent's room early one morning to ask him a question and saw the respondent's face in "Jellys" butt and she was pressed up against the wall naked. Jelly is the nickname for the respondents 17-year-old girlfriend.

The following month, our son stated that the respondent and "Jelly" were humping and making moaning noises in the pool while he and his brother were swimming. That same week, our son stated he was playing outside with the respondent. The respondent told him he would be right back and went inside. After several minutes, our son walked in and saw the respondent's face in "Jellys" private parts on the couch. The same month, our son disclosed that late one night, our children were in their room playing when they heard the baby let out a loud cry. Our son said he ran out of his room to check and saw the respondent's privates in "Jellys" mouth.

On 07/24/2023, our youngest stated "Daddy spank my tushy." I asked our eldest son if that was true and he said yes. Two days later, our sons witnessed the respondent and "Jelly" get into a massive fight. Our son stated "Jelly" was yelling at the respondent while holding their baby and cursing telling him to hit her.

1 On 08/07/2023, our eldest son was crying when I picked them up. He stated the respondent hit 2 him for hitting his little brother. He also stated that the respondent and "Jelly" got into a big fight 3 where they were yelling and saying the F-word a lot. He also stated he woke up to see the 4 respondent and "Jelly" humping in the bed next to him. They continued to do so after they noticed 5 our son was awake. 6 On 08/21/2023, our son stated "Jelly" told him that the respondent hit her in the face hard and 7 made her cry. She told our son not to tell the respondent. 8 9 On 08/23/2023, I spoke to the respondent and he stated he would "handle it". I told the respondent 10 that it was extremely inappropriate and that "Jelly" had no business telling our son what she did. 11 On 01/02/2024, our son disclosed that the respondent and "Jelly" got into a big fight while they 12 were over at his house. Our son stated the respondent and "Jelly" were yelling at one another. 13 Our son heard loud banging noises coming from the respondent's room. When the respondent 14 came out, our son saw the TV was smashed and the respondent's hand was bleeding. 15 The respondent was arrested for the 2nd time on 02/09/2024 for Rape of a Child in the 3rd degree. 16 17 He made bail. It is my understanding that more criminal charges are pending. 18 I believe the respondent is a flight risk as he has previously taken our children in 2021. I did not 19 see our children for an entire 3 weeks. The respondent made false claims against me with no 20 evidence. The claim was thrown out and the respondent was ordered to return the children. I do 21 believe the respondent will flee and take our children with him if he has access to them. 22 I am asking the court for a Protection Order against the respondent due to the active criminal 23 charges against him, the nature of those charges, the conduct that has been disclosed since his 24 arrest, and the fear I have of the respondent taking our children.
