

Synopsis: Report of possible sex assault

Narrative: On 05-21-19 at approximately 1946 hours, Lieutenant Watts called me to advise of an internal investigation at Washington Middle School involving a 12 year old female student (70) and the school's resource officer, Officer E. Huizar. She told me this female was alleging via social media that she and Officer Huizar were having sexual relations. Lieutenant Watts informed me that she would be meeting with the school's administration tomorrow morning and that I would be meeting with the school's principal (Bill Hilton) and vice principal (Susan Cordova) after her.

On 05-22-19 in the morning, Lieutenant Watts met with me in my office. She instructed me to go to Washington Middle School to interview the principle and vice principle in order to get names of students who had received instant messages from A 76 regarding her allegations of a sexual relationship. Lieutenant Watts also told me that students had completed written statements at the school's request and that I should gather those as well.

At approximately 0927 hours, Special Assault Unit Detective M. Durbin and I arrived at Washington Middle School and contacted Principal Hilton and Vice Principal Cordova in Vice Principal Cordova's office.

It should be noted that Vice Principal Cordova is married to a Yakima Police Officer.

They told me in November of 2018, Officer Huizar broke up a fight at the school between two girls. One of the girls was A 70 S 70 and that she had been infatuated with Officer Huizar ever since. They told me S 70 would follow Officer Huizar around the school so often that they had to tell her to stay away from Officer Huizar. They believed her attentions towards Officer Huizar had cooled until a few weeks ago, when several students informed them that S 70 was talking about her infatuation with Officer Huizar again.

At that point, Principal Hilton and Vice Principal Cordova called a meeting with Size and her guardian, who is also her grandmother, Anna Wells. They told me Size denied ever alleging anything inappropriate between her and Officer Huizar. They sent her home for the day after that meeting.

On May 17th of this year, Vice Principal Cordova advised me that the father of a student (A[7a]] B[7a] (a) called the school to advise them that he heard from his daughter that "A[7c] (b) was going around school telling people that she lost her virginity to Officer Huizar and that they were having a relationship. They told me they "emergency expelled" S[7c] (a) at that time,

I asked Vice Principal Cordova if there were any notes from the expulsion that I could have a copy of and she printed out that incident's notes as well as notes pertaining to Second past discipline report. I scanned and attached them to this report.

Vice Principal Cordova also had digital screenshots of messages with students that alleged Size was in a physical relationship with Officer Huizar. Detective Durbin obtained digital copies of those from Vice Principal Cordova. Vice Principal Cordova advised there was an allegation in the instant messages that Size saw a picture of Officer Huizar without a shirt on. She surmised that if a picture like this existed on the internet, it would have been from Officer Huizar's facebook posts since he is "into bodybuilding". Vice Principal Cordova advised that she had to suggest to Officer Huizar that he make his facebook account private soon after he started his job as the school's resource officer. She did this in order to prevent students from viewing his personal pictures. I later scanned and attached the printed copies of the instant messages to this report.

Vice Principal Cordova advised some of the students have completed written statements however she would have to gather the rest. I told her I wouldn't be collecting any of the statement forms today because I wasn't sure if my agency would be conducting the criminal investigation into S[7c] allegations. I told her my department would have to get back with her with regards to what agency will be investigating. Later in the shift, I reported my findings with Captain Seely.

Narrative:

On 05/23/2019 at approximately 1515hrs, I spoke with Ann Wells via telephone regarding the incident involving her grand-daughter (A70)— S70). I told Ann that the Yakima Police Department would not likely end up doing the investigation but that I was calling in an effort to have a victim advocate assigned to work with A70 — Ann told me that she did not believe the "poor officer" did anything with A70 — and that she didn't want to see the officer suffer harm for something that didn't happen. I advised that I wasn't in a position to speak about the merits of the case but at I wanted to ensure A70 — and their family had access to the resources that could be made available to them through working with an advocate. Ann told me that she would speak with an advocate and that I had permission to forward her name and contact information to the ASPEN victim advocacy program.

I concluded my telephone call with Ann and I made telephone contact with ASPEN victim advocacy team leader Debbie Brockman. I gave Debbie a brief synopsis of the allegations in this case and I told her that Ann was interested in speaking with an advocate on A behalf. Debbie told me that she would contact Ann immediately and our conversation was concluded.

On 05/24/2019 at approximately 1531hrs, I received a telephone call from Cpt. S. Boyle (Yakima Police Department). Cpt. Boyle requested that I go to Washington Middle School and obtain records from Vice Principal Sara Cordova. Cpt. Boyle advised that some of the records might not be reviewable at the time due to existing privacy rights, thus I should not review those documents but should log them into evidence. I was aware of the potential privacy interests that Cpt. Boyle was referring to, as the matter had been discussed a day earlier by my supervisor (Sgt. R. Baker, Yakima Police Department Special Assault Unit). I knew that this privacy matter was specific to the release of student witness statements and the student records of A [7c] S [7c].

I arrived at Washington Middle School at approximately 1545hrs and I met with Sara Cordova in her office. Sara explained that she had obtained a signed release for A [7c] S[7c] 'records earlier in the day, specifically allowing the school to release those records to the Yakima Police Department. Sara showed me the release and the documents that fell under the purview of the release. Sara showed me the student information profiles for the students that the school had contacted as potential witnesses in this incident. There were written statements attached to these profiles and I did not look at or review the statements. I obtained the documents from Sara and I left without further incident.

I returned to the Yakima Police Department and I copied the records that fell under the scope of the signed release from A [70] S [70] and her grandmother (Ann Wells). I also made photocopies of the student witness profiles (that contained names, addresses and contact numbers) but I did not view or examine the written statements. The formally released records and student profiles are attached to this report for investigator reference. Sgt. Baker watched as I copied these documents and then placed all of the original documents (to

DG-00007 PRR-2024-0122 include the unviewed statements) into a manila envelope. I promptly sealed this envelope with evidence tape and tagged the documents into the Yakima Police Department's secure evidence and property room.

SUBJECT:

Washington Middle School Investigation

On Monday, June 3rd, 2019, I assigned to assist the Yakima Police Department with a sexual assault investigation. I was provided with YPD Incident Report # 19Y018847. The report centered on the possible sexual contact between a YPD School Resource Officer (Elias Huizar) and a student (A [7c] S [7c]) at Washington Middle School.

On Thursday, June 6th, 2019, I met with the Yakima Chief of Police, Yakima County Prosecutor, and members of the Yakima Police Command Staff for a briefing on the case file which centered on a review of the information noted in the original Incident Report. YPD Sergeant R. Baker was assigned to assist me with any logistical matters during the investigation.

I made arrangements to meet with Washington Middle School staff on the morning of June 6th, 2019. We met in the school office.

Sara Cordova:

Cordova is the school's Vice-Principal. We met in private in her office beginning at 11:15 am.

Cordova has been with the Yakima School District for about 18 years. She has been a Vice-Principal for the past 7 years.

Asked to talk about how this incident began, Cordova said that it started in January of this year. She handed me a typed timeline of events she completed regarding student A [7c] S [7c]. I reviewed the paper and noted that it appeared she had written the name "A [7a] " in place of "A [7c] " in a few spots. She acknowledged that and wrote in the name "A [7c] " and initialed them.

She said that A [70] and another student – A [7a] B [7a] — have a long history of animosity towards each other. She noted the dispute extends to the families of both kids and extends back to when both students were in elementary school.

On January 11th, 2019, both students were involved in a physical fight on campus.

Officer Huizar broke up the fight by himself. While attempting to remove A[7a] from the fight, A[7c] hit A[7a]. A[7a] complained to her parents, who in turn complained to the school, that she (A[7a]) felt Huizar was holding her to allow A[7c] to land another punch. A[7c] was suspended for 5 days as a result of the incident. A[7a] was not suspended. It was noted that A[7c] had a history of fighting and disrespectful behavior which lead to the decision to impose that punishment as a form of progressive discipline. The complaint was investigated by the school which included reviewing school security camera footage. Huizar's supervisor was notified and he also investigated the matter. It was determined that no such advantage was given to A[7c].

After that incident, the school began to note that A [70] seemed to be infatuated with Huizar. Asked for examples, Cordova said that during lunch periods, A [70] would stand by Huizar and seem to move about the floor with him. The same was seen when Huizar would take up post in the field outside of school during the lunch periods. Cordova said both she and Principal Hilton saw this happening and that it was being done frequently enough to notice.

On January 18th, 2018, it was reported by a student (M[7a] C[7a]) that A[7c] had said she liked Huizar.

A 70 and her grandmother (listed guardian for student) had a meeting with Principal Hilton and A 70 was told to stay away from Huizar.

Cordova said that the incident was being handled by Principal Hilton. She said that she believes Hilton and Huizar spoke about it and Huizar noted he was uncomfortable about it.

Cordova felt that things had simmered down and then in March it began again. On March 5th, 2019, student M[7a] A[7a] reported that A[7c] was heard saying she wanted to have sex with Huizar. Cordova noted that M[7a] has a history of "story telling". She has reported things in the past that were false and they weren't sure how much stock to take in what she was reporting.

Also on March 5th, it was noted that other students began reporting to Mr. Zuniga (School Security Officer) that A was posting on SnapChat (social media) that she was dating Huizar. Several students also reported the same information to office. Asked why she thought the students were reporting this information, Cordova surmised that they weren't sure what to do for their friend and that others thought it was weird or gross and didn't know what to do.

When asked, Cordova said that report and the contact with A [7a] was not reported to the School District office or DSHS/Child Protective Services at that point. Asked if it was reported to the Yakima Police Department, she said she didn't know. Asked if Officer Huizar was made aware of it, she said she thought so.

Cordova said that Principal Hilton handled the investigation of this and that he spoke with A and her grandmother about it around that same time frame. Both denied that A had wrote the SnapChat messages and that it was possible the account was hacked by other students.

Note: The time line provided seems to note that the meeting between Hilton and the student and Grandmother took place in early May.

Cordova said that the students were ultimately told to write out statements (all dated between May 8th and 22nd). The students were told not to talk to each other this matter.

Cordova said that she did not interview A [7a] at that time. It was handled by Hilton who spoke with both A [7a] and her grandmother. On May 17th, Hilton placed A [7a] on emergency expulsion from school and notified the School District Office about the matter.

It was noted that Cordova is married to a Yakima Police Officer. She said that her husband (John Cordova) has been with YPD for 18 years. Asked if she had a conversation with her husband about this matter, she said that she told him a little bit about it in April. She told him there were some allegations being made against the officer at the school. She did not ask him for advice on how to handle it but rather as conversation between spouses about things at work. She didn't think she gave him specific details.

Asked how well she knows Huizar, she said she only met him this year. When asked, she said they don't socialize with other and didn't think her husband socializes with him. Asked about ever seeing him outside of school, she said that she hasn't except for a Christmas party she hosted for all school personnel at her home. She said Huizar and his wife attended that party.

Asked about talking to Huizar about his Facebook account, Cordova said that she had heard rumors in the school that some kids had seen pictures of him on FB. She said that she heard he is into bodybuilding and competitions and had won some tournaments. There were some pictures posted about that. She had heard that some of the students had looked him up on FB. She didn't talk to him about it specifically. She noted that a lot of school staff don't realized they need to set their FB accounts to 'private' when they start working at a school because the kids will attempt to look them up. She reported that students have reported that A[7a] has pictures of him on her SnapChat account. She also noted that students have reported A[7a] taking pictures of Huizar at school with her phone and then making "stickers" of them for SnapChat postings.

Asked if she has any concerns about Huizar or his conduct at school with A[7a] or any other student, Cordova said she doesn't. She said she doesn't believe the rumors or postings are true.

Asked if any staff member has reported anything to her about Huizar that has caused any concern, she said she hasn't had any such reports or complaints.



William Hilton:

Hilton is the school's Principal. I met with him in his office at about 12:25 pm.

Hilton has been a Principal in the Yakima School District for about 20 years. He has served as the Washington Middle School Principal for the last 5 years. He said that he and his Vice-Principals divide up the grades for discipline purposes and he predominately handles the 6th graders.

The school day starts at 8:00 am with the doors opening at 7:30 am for breakfast. The school day ends at 2:30 pm.

Hilton said he met Huizar this school year. When asked, he said he has not seen the Officer socially outside of school.

Asked about the history between A and A and A and A hilton said it started in elementary school. He noted that the girls' parents don't like each other and have history between them as well. He said there was a fight between the girls earlier this year that was broken up by Huizar on campus. A parents made a complaint that Huizar had held her while A hit her. The complaint was investigated by the school and was deemed to be unfounded. Hilton said that they reviewed the security tapes at the time in that investigation. Further, he said he did report it to the Yakima Police Department and they had a supervisor investigate it as well.

Hilton said that after that incident, they noticed that A colored was following Huizar around campus. She would stand by him in the mornings and at lunch. He referred to her as "always by him". Asked if he spoke with Huizar about it early on, he said he didn't. He did talk to A colored and her grandmother about it and told the student to stop doing it. He said that in the weeks that followed after that, A colored would come to him and ask him if she "could go back" to being by Huizar. He continued to tell her she could not do so. He said she never told him why she wanted to hang around the Officer. Hilton said this all took place in the January – February time frame. Asked if he reported this to the School District Office, he said he did not. It was also not reported to the Police Department.

On March 5th, he said made a report in which she said A was posting messages on SnapChat saying she and Huizar were dating. Hilton noted that had a history in the school of making false accusations and he didn't feel it was valid. He said he did talk to A and she denied making the postings. He said he also spoke after that with A grandmother and she denied it was true.

When asked, he said he did talk to Huizar about this and the Huizar told him that she (A 70) made him uncomfortable and he didn't want her hanging around him.

When asked, Hilton said he did not report this to the School District Office or to Huizar's supervisor.

Hilton said, "We handled it – we couldn't verify it". He also added that they talked to some more about it and she seemed to "back off some" on her statement regarding it.

Hilton said that the rest of March and April were quiet. In May, several girls came into the office to report that A was talking about dating Huizar and being sexually active with him. He said he ultimately had them write out statements. They took some pictures of the postings.

He said he put A on emergency expulsion. He met with A on her grandmother and showed them the posts and statements. A denied she made the posts and said her account must have been hacked. Hilton said he notified the School District Office on Friday, May 17th. He believed he notified Amanda Jewell and Stacy Lock at the District Office. (Note: the handwritten statements by students varied in dates. Some were dated 05/08 and some 05/17. Most were 05/22 or after)

Asked if he reported the incident to the Yakima Police Department, he said he didn't. He said he did call Huizar into his office and asked if any of the postings were true. Huizar said they were not true. Hilton didn't recall the date of that conversation.

Hilton explained that an emergency expulsion is for up to 10 days to allow them to investigate. He said that Huizar was removed from the school by YPD after that. The 10-day expulsion ended last Friday (05/31). He was advised by the School District to allow A back into school.

Hilton noted that Monday (06/03) was A [70] s first day back after the suspension. He met with her that morning before classes and told her not to talk about why she was suspended or talk about Huizar. He said he told her grandmother that would be a condition of her return to school. He told the grandmother that the preceding Friday (05/31). Hilton said that he was advised by his security officer – Mr. Zuniga – that a friend of A [70] had come to him that morning and asked where Officer Huizar was and why he wasn't on campus. Hilton felt that it may have been asked at A [70] s behest. He called her into the office to ask about it and A [70] denied that she had anything to do with it.

Asked if he had any concerns about Huizar, Hilton said that when Huizar first started at the school there was some question about the humor he was using around students. It was reported to him by some teachers that Huizar was making comments such as "I'm your daddy" to students. Hilton said he counselled Huizar about it – telling him that it was inappropriate humor for the students. He said he felt that Huizar was doing it simply to be funny.

Asked about any other concerns, Hilton said there have been "none that I have seen".

Asked if he felt that his vice-principal (Ms. Cordova) might cover up anything done by Huizar out of allegiance to the police based on her husband's occupation, Hilton said he had no concerns about that. He said, "She is very child-focused and would do anything to protect kids".

Herberto Zuniga:

Zuniga is the school's security officer. He is employed by the Yakima School District. He has been a security officer for several years and has spent the last three years at Washington Middle School.

Zuniga said that he shares an office with Huizar. He does not see Huizar socially. When asked, he said he has never seen Huizar alone with a student. He said Huizar is friendly and would talk with any student who came to see him. He never saw Huizar seek out any particular student. He said they generally work together in the school and are frequently together when in the commons or out on the field.

Asked what he knew about the allegations, she said that he knew some students were saying that A was posting about Huizar. He said he didn't want to get involved with it because it was a serious matter and he would refer any student who would talk about it Principal Hilton. He said he never interviewed any student about it. He was present in the office when Vice Principal Cordova and Vice Principal Mifflin were taking some pictures of postings off students' phones. He didn't know that the postings said.

Asked if A column ever made any disclosures or statements to him about Huizar or any other adult, Zuniga said she did not.

Asked what happened this past Monday, he said that several students came up to him in the commons area. They approached him as a group and one of them asked, "Is Officer Huizar coming back?" He said he didn't answer the question and sent them away. He said he didn't remember who asked the question. He said, when asked, that it was not A [70]...

Cordova confirmed that she and Vice Principal Mifflin had taken the pictures of the SnapChat texts from the cell phones of R[7a] G[7a] and Y[7a] R[7a]. She said that she took the pictures with her own cell phone and then printed them out and turned them over to the Yakima Police when the incident was reported.

Student Contacts:

I asked Ms. Cordova to set up the opportunity to speak with students regarding their statements. Each was called to the office during the afternoon of 06/06/19 and the morning of 06/07/19. All took place in Cordova's office and she was present for each of them. It should be noted that while she remained present, she didn't participate in any of the questioning.

As each student came into the office, I introduced myself and said that I was working with the police and wanted to ask some questions. I told each that they were not in trouble and that they didn't have to talk to me if they didn't want to do so. I told each that I wanted them to be truthful, correct any mistakes I made in saying anything, that they could tell me if they didn't know an answer to my question, that I didn't want them to guess at answers, and could ask me to explain anything I said that they didn't understand. Each student agreed to this prior to the start of the interview. None expressed any concern at being questioned and none asked for anyone else to be present. All were okay with Ms. Cordova being present.

A[7a] B[7a] :

A [7a] said that she and A [7c] are friends "now". She said that they liked each other in 3rd grade but then had a fight and didn't like each other. She said she and A [7c] did get into a fight earlier this year at school. Asked what it was about, she said she didn't remember anymore why they fought. Asked when they last talked to each other, she said she and A [7c] talked to each other at lunch that day.

Asked if A[7c] said anything to her about Officer Huizar, A[7a] said that A[7c] told her that they were dating and that she lost her virginity to him. She said it was about two weeks ago when A[7c] came to her and said she wanted to tell her something. When A[7a] asked her what it was, A[7c] told her about Huizar.

Asked if she believed A common when she said that, A common said, "For a second". A common said that on Monday, when A common back to school, A common told her that she and Officer Huizar "broke up".

Asked what else A 70 has told her about Officer Huizar, A 7a said that A 70 has told her that he is "cute" ad that they have talked to each other on SnapChat. Asked if she's seen any of the conversations on SnapChat or any other texts, A 7a said she hasn't.

Asked if she told anyone about what A To told her, A Ta said she told her parents and her dad said he was going to call Mr. Hilton.

Asked if anyone else at the school ever told her anything about Huizar, A[7a] said, "Not to me".



$M_{7a} N, C_{7a} (7a)$:

M^{7a} is in the 6th grade at Washington Middle School. She said she has known A^{7c} since they were in elementary school together. She said that she and A^{7c} "don't get along".

Asked to tell me what happened with A 70 she said that A 70 told her she was "sleeping with the Officer". M 7a said that she has been saying this for most of the school year. She said that A 70 also said they "were doing other stuff". Asked to tell me what that meant, she said it was embarrassing but she did agree to tell me. She said A 70 has said that she and Huizar had sex at his house and in his car. A 70 told her that Huizar would drop her off at school in the mornings and has taken her to the Olive Garden Restaurant to eat with him. A 70 said that Huizar is married and has two kids. She said that Huizar is leaving his wife for her (A 70).


Asked if she has ever seen A[7c] with Huizar outside of school, M[7a] she hasn't and added that she doesn't hang out with A[7c]. Asked if she's ever seen them alone together at school, she said she has seen them talking on the field. She said that when Huizar has been standing alone, A[7c] has gone up to him. Asked if she's ever seen the two of them walk away from the field or commons area alone together, she said she hasn't.

Asked if she was part of a group that went to see Mr. Zuniga on Monday to ask about the Officer, she said she was. She said that they all wanted to know if the Officer was in trouble. Asked why she wanted to know that, M7al said, "He didn't do it. She did".

She said that she told A[7c] today that she doesn't trust her anymore and A[7c] called her a "dumbass".

M7a opened her SnapChat account using Cordova's phone and located chats/texts she said were sent by A7c — screen name 'lowkeyy'. I took photos of them (17 photos). They have dates on the text exchanges of April 24th, 29th, and 30th and May 17th, 18th and 19th. It was noted that on some of the texts/chats, A7c was named 'Hermana A7c '. M7a said that one can change the name of anyone on their end of the text chats and she gave that name to A7c ...



NOTE:

At the conclusion of the interview with M[7a] and after she left the office, I asked Cordova if Huizar was married and if he had two kids. She said that he was married with two kids. She also noted that he coaches wrestling at the school and has frequently brought his wife and children to wrestling matches on campus.

D[7a] P. O[7a]

D[7a] is a 6th grade student. She said she knows A[7c] from school and met her this school year. Asked if they were friends, she said, "not anymore". Asked why, D[7a] said that A[7c] has been fighting with her other friend – M[7a].

Asked if A [76] ever talked about Officer Huizar, she said A [76] sent her a message on SnapChat saying that she and Huizar had slept together and that she goes to his house and he drops her off at school. D [7a] said that A [7c] sent her a picture of two people holding hands. Asked who was in the picture, D [7a] said that there were no faces in the picture but she thinks A [7c] wanted her to believe it was A [7c] and Huizar. Asked when that was, she said she didn't remember. Asked if it was before or after Valentine's Day, she said it was after. Asked about other dates, D [7a] said she didn't know and couldn't pin down the date any further. She didn't have the texts anymore.

Asked if she ever saw A and Huizar away from school, she said she hadn't. Asked if she's ever seen them in or near Huizar's car, she said she hadn't.

Valeria is a 6th grader at the school. She said she has known A 7c since 3rd grade. Asked if they were friends, she said they were.

Asked if she ever heard A [70] talk about Officer Huizar, she said that she has heard A [70] say that she goes to his house and are dating. She said she wanted him to go to the social (school dance set for 6/7/19) with her. V [7a] said A [70] asked her to ask Huizar if he was going to the dance. V [7a] said she didn't do it. She said this conversation took place about one month ago. She was unable to be more specific about the date.

Asked when the last time she remembered A[70] talking about the Huizar was, V[7a] said that she remembered asking A[70] if it was true about her and Huizar. She said A[70] said she didn't want to talk about it. Asked when that was, she said it was the day that A[70] came to the after-school program.

Asked if she ever saw A[7c] and Huizar together off campus, she said she hadn't.

Y[7a] is a 6th grade student at the school. She knows A[7c] from school. She said they were friends but really aren't anymore.

Y [7a] said that she has seen A [7c] with her phone out filming Officer Huizar while he was on campus. Asked if A [7c] said anything about the filming, she said A [7c] didn't. Asked if she knew why A [7c] was filming him, she said she didn't.

Asked if she has ever seen A and Huizar together off campus, she said she hasn't and that she doesn't "really hang with her" outside of school.



R[7a] J. G[7a] :

R[7a] is a 6th grade student at the school. She knows A[7c] from school. She said they aren't really friends anymore.

Asked if she knew anything about A and Huizar, she said heard at school that A and Officer Huizar were dating and had been together. R as said she texted A responded with, "Yes but don't tell anyone. If you do, I'll fight you". Asked if she still had the text on her phone, she said she didn't.

Asked when that exchange took place, she didn't remember. Asked if it was before or after Valentine's Day, she said it was after. Asked if it was before or after Memorial Day, she said she didn't remember.

Asked if she had ever seen A 70 and Huizar together outside of school, she said she didn't. She said that she has seen A 70 talking to Huizar outside in the field during lunch.

Family of Student A[70] S[70]:

On 06/05/19, in the afternoon, after learning that I had been assigned to this case, I contacted Ann Wells who was listed in the police report as the student's grandmother and guardian. The purpose of the call was to introduce myself and schedule an appointment time to meet with her. She agreed to meet with me during the evening of 06/6/19.

I contacted Debbie Brockman, Program Manager of Aspen Victim Advocacy Services in Yakima and requested that we be allowed to use her facility for an interview with Ms. Wells and A[7a] S[7a]. Brockman said her office had been contacted by the Yakima Police Department and asked to offer advocacy services to the family. She noted that she had been in contact with both Wells and A[7c] and agreed to allow the use of their facility.

Brockman noted that she has met with A[7c]. Her contacts with A[7c] are private based on her position as a community-based advocate. However, Brockman noted that she is a mandatory reporter and was able to state that A[7c] has not made any disclosures of sexual contact with Huizar or by any other adult.

Ms. Ann Wells:

On 06/06/19, at about 5:30 pm. I met with Ms. Ann Wells at the Aspen facility in Yakima. She had A with her. Brockman agreed to sit with the student while Wells and I spoke in a private office.

Wells said that she is A[7a] maternal grandmother. She explained that A[7a] 's mother (Tiffany Penaloza) lives in Yakima and has limited contact with A[7a]. The mother has a history of narcotics addiction and a history of domestic violence issues and agreed to have Wells take care of A[7a] and her brother (Damien – age 10). She said she has been caring for the kids for most of their lives. She noted she doesn't have court-ordered custody of the children but rather is operating on informal agreement with the mother.

Wells said that A [7a] are's father is Adrian Escobar. She said that he wasn't in A [7a] are's life until October of 2017. She said that he came to Washington State at that time after fleeing arrest warrants in Indiana and North Carolina. On Christmas Day of 2017, he was killed in a confrontation with Yakima Police.

Wells is married to Florberto Wells.



When asked, Wells said that A is not diagnosed with any physical or mental health issues and is not on any medications. Asked about her school performance, she said that A is behind in her studies but isn't on an IEP and doesn't have any learning disabilities.

When asked, Wells said that A has never run away from home or had any unexplained absences from the family.

She described A as a "sensitive and caring girl" and said that she cares about others around her and likes to help the homeless.

Wells said that A 7c often goes by the nickname "Jelly".

Asked if she knew A to be sexually active, she said her granddaughter was not sexually active. Asked if she has noted any sexualized behaviors, she said she has not.

Asked to talk about A school schedule and how she gets to/from school, Wells said that she drives A to and from school daily. When she is unable to do so, her husband will do it. Asked if A ever takes the school bus or goes with friends or on her own to school, she said that has never happened.

As for extracurricular activities, Wells said that A[76] has a mentor she sees periodically. She said the mentor is Teri Buchanan who works in the medical field at Virginia Mason Hospital. She sees her mentor every other month or so. They go out to eat and shop and talk. They visits are not overnight visits.

A 70 also attends a youth group program at Grace of Christ in Yakima. The group meets at the church on Wednesday evenings from 6:00 pm to 8:00 pm. Asked about getting to and from the group, Wells said that either she drives A 70 to and from the meetings or the church van comes for her. Again, she noted that A 70 to does not go on her own.

Asked about overnight visits or sleepover with friends, she said A[70] hasn't been on one except with family members, which is very infrequent. She doesn't allow A[70] to sleep at friend's houses.

Asked to talk about the last time that A was out with Wells know where she was or who she was with, Wells said it hasn't happened.

Wells said that she pays for A[70] so cell phone which is through Boost Mobile. It is an all-in-one prepaid account and they don't get itemized bills. She said A[70] does have a smart phone with internet access. Asked about email use, she said she didn't know if A[70] uses email.

Asked about A says about Officer Huizar, Wells said that her granddaughter has told her that he is "nice" and that she feels safe with him at the school. She said this is A first year in Middle School and her granddaughter wasn't sure she wanted to go there. A described it as a "dark and scary place". She said that having the Officer there made her feel safer.

We discussed, in general terms, the statements made by other students regarding A and Huizar. Wells said that she doesn't believe anything happened between them. She said that A compare has never made any disclosure to her or given her any reason to believe that something was going between her and the Officer. She said she has always had an open relationship with A could talk about anything. She said she has always instilled in her granddaughter that it was okay to tell her anything as long as it was the truth – no matter how bad it was.

Wells said that the school reported that A[7c] was following the Officer around and had to tell her to stop doing it. She said that A[7c] has said that she doesn't have any interest in the Officer other than him being there for safety. She said that her granddaughter has denied making the posts on SnapChat that are being attributed to her. Asked if she monitors A[7c] is SnapChat account, Wells said that she started once all this began. She said A[7c] is very upset about the other students spreading rumors about her at school.

Asked if she ever met the Officer, Wells said she had seen him at school but hasn't had any extended contact with him – nothing more than to say 'hello'. Asked if Huizar ever called her house, Wells said she didn't believe so. She said that someone called from the school to come and pick up A early from school and it may have been a security officer but she wasn't sure. She didn't recall when that was.

I explained the child interview process to her and secured her permission to speak with A [70]. We scheduled the interview for the following morning (06/07) at 8:30 am at the Aspen facility.

I asked her to introduce me to A [7c] before she left the facility. She agreed to do so and we moved to a conference room where A [7c] was sitting with Ms. Brockman. I introduced myself to her and told her that I was working with the police and wanted to ask her some questions about school and what was going on regarding the rumors about her. I told her she didn't have to talk to me and wouldn't be in trouble for not wanting to speak with me. I told her that she was not in trouble with me and that she wouldn't get into trouble as a result of speaking with me. She agreed to speak with me and I told her that I would see her in the morning.

A and her grandmother left the Aspen facility at about 6:15 pm.



A 7c S 7c - Child Forensic Interview:

On Friday, June 7, 2019, at about 8:20 am, I met with Ann Wells at the Aspen House. We again reviewed the interview process for her granddaughter and she consented to having it done. Ms. Wells remained in the waiting room during the interview of Afron.

I followed the Washington State Child Interview Guidelines in my interview with A[7c]. This included re-introducing myself, eliciting a promise from her to be truthful, and the general instructions of not guessing at answers, correcting any mistakes I make, asking for clarification if she doesn't understand a question and giving her permission to indicate she "doesn't know" if she doesn't know the answer to the question asked.

At A request, Advocate Debbie Brockman was present for the interview which was conducted in a private room at the Aspen House in Yakima. While she was present, Brockman did not ask any questions during the interview. The interview was audio recorded using a hand-held recording device. The interview began at about 8:35 am.

During event narrative practice (designed to demonstrate her ability to provide narrative responses to questions), A [70] talked about playing soccer and how she plays the game with her brother and neighbors. She discussed her enjoyment of the game and her desire to continue to play the game as she moves into high school.

Asked why she was being interviewed, A said that she was brought in to talk about 'rumors'. Asked to describe the rumors, she said the rumors were about a police officer. She said it was about Officer Huizar. She said she met Huizar at school. It is her first year at Washington Middle School and on the first day of school this year, she got into trouble with another student. While in the school office, Huizar had her write a statement about it. She said he also talked to her about not fighting and staying out of trouble.

A 76 described Huizar as "nice" and said he smiles a lot. She said that she has been around him at school and has talked with him there. She said that she and he weren't alone when they talked.

Asked to talk about the rumors, she said they were about her and Huizar dating. She denied the rumors were true. Asked how the rumors started, she said they came from a group of girls at school who were friends of hers and the girls "cause drama". She said the group of girls would fight and make up and fight again and she decided to stop being a friend with them. She said the rumors started just after she ended the friendship. She said she has asked some of the girls about it and they have admitted it to her but couldn't tell her why they did it. She said she thinks one of the girls who started the rumors is E[7a], a 6th grader at school. She didn't know E[7a] is last name but said they have known each other since elementary school.

Asked what type of car Huizar drives, she said he drove a police car. She said she had never been in it. She didn't know what type of car he drives when he isn't at work.

Asked about Huizar's house, she said she didn't know anything about his house. Asked about his family, she said that Huizar told her about his kids. She thought he told her that he had boys but she didn't know how old. She said she knows he is married because he wears a wedding ring.

Asked if she's ever seen Huizar outside of school, she said she hasn't. Asked if she was ever alone with him at school, she said she hasn't been. Told that others have said she has been alone with him and asked what the reason would be for them saying that, A said that she was scared to make new friends and she would hang out by him. She said that she wasn't alone with him and other students were around at the same time. She said that Huizar would talk to them all and that he would say funny things and talk about sports. She said he would tell them that he could beat them in race and then one of the people in the group, John, would race him. She said she would talk to him in the lunch room or on the track outside.

Told that part of my job was work with young people and help them if someone had hurt them or done something to make them feel uncomfortable, she was asked if something like that had happened. She said it did not.

When asked, A said her mentor is Teri B (she didn't know last name). She was able to provide me with Teri's phone number. She said she last saw Teri on a Sunday earlier this year but didn't remember when it was.

A said that her cell phone number is 509 7a. Asked what Huizar's phone number is, she said she didn't know. Asked about sending him a text or email, she said she had never done so.

Asked about her Snap Chat username, she said it is 'thiskid_1232". Asked if the name or numbers had any particular significance, she said they didn't. Asked about other names used, she said she had some others but don't use them anymore. Asked about "Low Key", she said she has used that username before.

June 12, 2019 Page 18

Told that I had seen texts that were identified as being from her under the Low Key username, said that her friend M[7a] (M[7a] C[7a]) had set up her account and used it. She said she had forgotten the password for the account and M[7a] had told her that she (M[7a]) was still logged in. When asked, she said that she didn't send the messages that the other girls are saying she sent.

When asked, she said she didn't know anything about Huizar's Facebook account.

Told that some of the students had noted she was suicidal as mentioned in texts, she said that she had thought about what it would be like if she were dead and then all this would be over. She said those feelings started when this all started. Asked if she was still feeling that way today, she said she wasn't. We discussed resources she has available should she feel that way again.

The interview ended at 9:11 am. A 70 was left in the care of Debbie Brockman. I met with Ann Wells and updated her on the interview.

Sergeant J. Deccio:

On Friday, June 7th, 2019, I met with Sergeant Deccio of the Yakima Police Department in his office. He is the supervisor of the YPD School Resource Officer Program.

Deccio said that Huizar has been working for him as a SRO for about 1.5 years. He said that Officers get some training on working in schools as Patrol Officers and then once selected as an SRO, they attend the week-long basic course and then a NASRO (National School Resource Officer) three-day class for advanced training. Huizar did complete these.

Asked about complaints, he said he has not received any about Huizar. He gets positive feedback about Huizar and notes that most feel he is engaged with his school staff and students.

June 12, 2019 Page 19

Deccio said that he became aware of this incident on May 21st or 22nd. He said Huizar called him to say that there was an incident at the school involving some social media accounts that had postings about him being in a relationship with a student. He said that a girl on campus was suspected on making the posts to others and that the school had handled it before but that it was starting up again. Deccio said he notified his command staff after speaking with Huizar. Per his command staff's orders, he did not investigate further.

Deccio confirmed that earlier this year there was a student fight that Huizar broke up and there was a complaint made by a parent of one of the students. Deccio said that he responded to that fight and it was cleared by both him and the school staff.

Asked if Huizar reported to him in January that there were concerns by the school about a female student following him around, he said Huizar didn't report that to him.

Asked if he was aware of the school principal counseling Huizar about inappropriate joking with students, he said he was not made aware of that.

Sergeant J. Deccio Yakima Police Department School Resource Officer Unit, Supervisor

Stacey Locke

On 06/07/19, in the afternoon, I met with Stacey Lock at the Yakima Public Schools Office. Locke is the Execute Director of Safety and Security for the school district.

She was aware of the incident and noted that the YSD is conducting an internal investigation into the matter. They are focusing on the school's response to the student and the handling of the potential disclosure by school staff in relation to mandatory reporting procedures.

Locke said that after Principal Hilton made the report to her office that the student was placed on emergency expulsion, she and Amanda Jewell (Director of Student Services) met at the school to begin the investigative process. She said the meeting, on May 21st at the school, was attended by the Principal, Vice-Principal and Officer Huizar. Locke and Jewell were told that this has been going on "for a while". Locke said that she spoke with Officer Huizar and advised him that he should contact his supervisor and report what happened and Huizar agreed to do so. She also contacted Mrs. Wells and secured a release form for the school to turn over records about A 70 stime at the school to the police.

Locke said that the YSD Office was not notified of the incident that took place in January and weren't aware of the on-going issues presented in this case.

She said there was no disclosure to her office or anyone else in the Superintendent's Office from A or her family. They are working with Mrs. Wells regarding services for the family and helping A or her family in school.

Teri Buchanan

On 06/06/19, at about 12:30 pm, I spoke with Teri Buchanan. She is a mentor with the Aspire Program through the YWCA. They work with at-risk youth. She said she does mentor A and tries to meet with her about once every other month or so.

They meet to talk about whatever issues A [70] may have and to provide a positive role model for her. She said that A [70] has had a lot of problems with homelessness in her life as well as issues with her biological mother. She said A [70] lives with her grandmother.

When asked, she said she last saw A[76] in mid-April. It was a Sunday and they went to church and then out to breakfast.

Buchanan said that A has not made any disclosure to her about a sexual relationship with anyone. When asked, she said that A hasn't talked to her about any boys or of anything sexual based.

Buchanan said that A 70 is close to her grandmother and Ms. Wells keeps tabs on them when they are out. Asked what that meant, she said that Wells wants to know where they are going and how long they will be out.

Buchanan said she feels she and A 7c have a good relationship and A 7c feels she can talk to her about whatever is one her mind.

Advised of the nature of this investigation, she said she was not aware of it and it hadn't come up in her time with A [76].

Buchanan is a Respiratory Therapist with Virginia Mason Hospital.

Thomas Sudbury:

On Saturday, 06/08/19, in the mid-morning, I spoke with Thomas Sudbury, the Youth Director for Grace of Christ Presbyterian Church in Yakima. Due to scheduling issues, we spoke for a short time and then completed our interview on Monday, 06/10/19, in the morning. I told him that I was investigating a report of possible sexual abuse involving A [70]. I did not give him any details about who the potential suspect was or his connection to her.

Sudbury confirmed that A [7c] is in the church's youth program which meets on Wednesday evenings. He said A [7c] attends almost every Wednesday and comes to Sunday mass at least once a month. Asked if he knew how she got to the youth program, he said that her grandmother drives her there most of the time. They also have a van that can do pick-ups and drop-offs.

Asked if A 70 has ever made any disclosures of being sexually active or being pressured into any sexual activity, he said she hadn't. He added that he and his staff have a mandatory reporting policy.

Asked if A every talked about anyone in her life or seemed focused on anyone outside of her family, Sundbury said that she once told him about a police officer at her school. I asked him to tell me about that. He said it was about 2 months ago. It came up because she pulled out her phone to take a picture of her and him together at the church and he saw she had a picture on her phone of her and a uniformed police officer. He asked about it and she told him she hangs out with the office at school. He recalled the picture was of A continuous the officer and another girl and it was clearly in a school setting. He didn't know the name of the officer or the other girl in the picture.

Sudbury said that A color got into an argument with a girl at youth group and noted that A color "won't back down". Asked to explain, she said that she and the girl argued and she called the girl a name while they were on the phone. That girl put her mom on the phone and yelled at A color and A color told Sudbury about it and said that she was "in a fight" with the girl's mom. He said that once she starts on something, she won't give it up.

He also noted that A has been caught saying some things that aren't true. Asked for an example, he said that when she first joined the group, she said that she had a 2 year old son. Sudbury asked her about that and she told him a story about her son. When Sudbury asked the leader of the church group she had previously belonged to, he learned that she was not a mother. The leader of that group told Sudbury, "she does that" meaning she sometimes makes up stories.

School Layout - Washington Middle School:

Washington MS is located in the City of Yakima at 510 S. 9th Street, Yakima, WA. The school is locked during the day and visitors must identify themselves via a call box prior to entry. The school's offices are located just inside the main doors. The row of offices also contain the offices of the Principal, Vice-Principals and school staff. The school security office is located within the secure office area. That office is shared by Mr. Zuniga and Officer Huizar.

The office leads out into the commons area. The commons area leads out to the wings containing the classrooms as well as exit to the field area.

Within the commons area are two custodial closets. They are at opposite ends of the commons area. The doors for both are within obvious view of anyone within the commons area. The doors are locked at all times when not in use by the custodian. Principal Hilton noted that Officer Huizar and Security Officer Zuniga have keys to those closets. Both doors are within view of the commons area security cameras. I took some photos of the closets.

It was noted in written statements by students that A and Zuniga had sex in the janitor's closet (See statement by A and F and a dated 05/23/19).

Principal Hinton noted that the school's camera system is on full time and the monitors are located within the main office and accessible to the staff. Inside the main office itself are large TV monitors mounted on the wall with rotating views of the school's cameras. They are always on and visible to anyone in the main office. It was noted that the cameras record to a hard drive that is maintained for one month before being re-written over.




In my interview with M[7a] C[7a], she noted that A[7c] told her that she and Huizar went to the Olive Garden for dinner. She was unable to say when that dinner would have happened. On 06/07/19, I spoke with the manager at the Olive Garden on E. Yakima Avenue with the intent to ask him to preserve any recorded video he may have from inside the restaurant. He advised that the business does not have any surveillance cameras in operation.

DCYF/CPS:

Detective Durbin of the Yakima Police Department generated a CPS Referral regarding this case. The intake was completed on 05/23/19 at 2:48 pm.

DCYF records shows that Referral ID# 449096 & 4149097 were generated out of the DCYF (Division of Children, Youth & Families) Toppenish Office. The Referrals were not assigned out to a social worker for investigation.

Contact with Elias Huizar and Amber Rodriquez:

On Friday, 06/07/19, at about 4:45 pm, I left a voice mail for Elias Huizar asking for contact to set up an interview.

I then called Amber Rodriquez. She is married to Huizar. I reached her on her cell phone and advised of the purpose of my call. She said she was tied up at that moment out of the house and took my cell number. I confirmed with her that the number I had for Huizar and left the message on was his cell phone number.

Having not heard back from Ms. Rodriquez by Monday, I called her again at 9:00 am. She said that she and her husband had spoken and they had been advised to wait on speaking with me. When asked, she said that they are consulting an attorney. She did note that she would be willing to speak with me at some point.

On Monday, June 10, 2019, at about 10:00 am, I received a call from Attorney David Allen (One Union Square, 600 University Street, Suite 3020, Seattle, WA 98101; 206-447-9681). He advised that he had been retained by Huizar. I reviewed for him the outline of the investigation and requested contact with his client. He agreed to speak with his client and notify me after that is complete. I left a voice mail for Mr. Allen on June 11, 2019, in the early evening requesting contact.

Investigative Findings:

A To S S S is in her first year as a student at Washington Middle School. Officer Elias Huizar, a Yakima Police Officer, is assigned as the School Resource Officer at Washington Middle School.

Several students report being told by S[7c] that she has been dating and is possibly sexually active with Huizar. The reported contacts have taken place both on campus (custodial closet) and off campus (his house and car as well as the Olive Garden Restaurant). None of the interviewed students have specific dates/times/locations of the contacts and none has first-hand knowledge of the contacts/encounters.

Several students report having electronic messages, via SnapChat, reportedly sent by talking about her relationship with Huizar. S[76] denies sending the messages.

In a forensic interview with S[7c], she has denied sexual contact with Huizar.

S[7c] guardian – her grandmother – reports that S[7c] does not travel to/from school on her own or with friends. The grandmother reports that she drives S[7c] to school each day and can account for her time when out of school.

The known adults in S[76] 'life were located and contacted (grandmother, school staff, youth director, mentor and advocate). None reported any disclosures by S[76] nor were they able to identify any concerning behaviors indicating sexual abuse by Huizar.

No one identified has reported any behaviors by Huizar that were considered concerning regarding sexual contact with minors.

A[7c] and A[7a] B[7a] get in a fight-ongoing issue between the girls since elementary school. A complained was suspended for 5 days. A complained to Mr. Hilton that Officer Huizar held A 7a so that A 7c could hit her. This was 1/11/2019 not found to be true. Sergeant Deccio is informed of the allegation and comes to talk with both Officer Huizar and Mr. Hilton. Re-engagement meeting for A 7c Grandma also attended. 7a made comments about liking Officer Huizar and it was noticed that she had been 1/18/2019 standing by him frequently in the Commons. During this meeting, A 7a was told to stay away from Officer Huizar. Student M[7a] A[7a] wrote an incident report that A[7c] was telling her that 3/5/2019 she wanted to have sex with Officer Huizar. A 70 heard that M 7a reported it to someone so she threatened her. **See Report. was told to stop talking about Officer Huizar. Grandma was called and informed of the allegations. Grandma said it didn't happen and that the student 3/5/2019 was lying. The student had been in trouble for making up false reports regarding other situations earlier this year. Students began coming to security and office and reporting tha 7al Snapchat messages and verbally telling them that she and Officer Huizar were dating. Mr. Hilton called Grandma and she came in to meet. Mr. Hilton reiterated that A70 needed to stop talking about Officer Huizar and stop sending messages about him to her friends. A 7c denied sending messages and denied 5/8 and 5/9/2019 talking about Officer Huizar, Grandma also denied and suggested that someone was hacking A 70 s account. Grandma vehemently denied that anything was going on between A and Officer Huizar. A c is sent home for the remainder of the day. She is not to talk about Officer Huizar or send messages. She must continue to stay away. Mr. Hilton had a conversation with Officer Huizar, asking him if there was anything going on between him and A 70 . He stated that there was nothing at all. 5/9/2019 Continued reports from various students that A 70 is continuing to talk about dating Officer Huizar and continuing to send messages about him. Students are 5/10-5/17 concerned. **See Reports.

Timeline A<mark>70 S.70</mark> s

b's dad, Michael, calls and talks to Mr. Mifflin to report that A 7c is telling A 7a that she is dating Officer Huizar and having sex with him; 5/17/2019 that she lost her virginity to him. Dad is concerned. Mr. Hilton called Amanda Jewell, director of Student Services, YSD, and asked for 5/17/2019 advice from her regarding this situation. She asked to have time to think about what to do over the weekend. A 7C 's Grandma is called to come to school. A 7C has continued to send messages and talk to her friends regarding her allegations that she is dating and having sex with Officer Huizar. Grandma is informed that A 70 has continued with her messages, Mr. Hilton reads the messages that he has been given copies of 5/17/2019 aloud to A 70 and Grandma. A 70 continues to deny responsibility. Grandma again suggess that her account has been hacked. A region is emergency expelled. **See Reports 5/20/2019 Mr. Hilton calls and sets up a meeting with Amanda Jewell and Stacey Locke to talk with Officer Huizar about incidents/situation. It is decided that we will meet with Grandma and A7c at the District Office on Friday, June 24 at noon. 5/21/2019 Officer Huizar informs Mrs. Cordova that he has been told to not come to school on 05/22/2019. He states that Lieutenant Watts and Captain Boyle will be coming in the morning to talk with Mr. Hilton. 5/22/2019 Mr. Zuniga (Security) calls students to his office to get statements and pictures from Snapchat. Students indicate that they don't believe A 70 story/messages. **See Reports -- pictures have been sent to Detective Durbin. 5/22/2019 Lieutenant Watts and Captain Boyle meet with Mr. Hilton and Mrs. Cordova to discuss situation and to inform that an investigation will need to be done at this point. 5/22/2019 Detectives Baker and Durbin come to meet with Mr. Hilton and Mrs. Cordova. They will need any investigation and reports as well as a timeline. Another agency may be helping with the investigation.
