On 02/03/2024 I was working as a uniformed Police Officer for the City of West Richland. I was wearing my class B uniform and was driving a fully marked patrol vehicle. At approximately 0042 hours I was dispatched to the area of 1st and Kennedy Rd, Benton City, WA to assist Deputies with the Benton County Sheriff's

I was informed that Deputies were out with two females reporting an incident that occurred at 2507 S Highlands Blvd within the City of West Richland, WA.

Upon arrival, I was informed that both females were in the GMC Canyon (WA C22136L). I was informed that the females were reporting a sexual assault that occurred at 2507 S Highlands Blvd in the City of West Richland. The female in the passenger seat was determined to be the victim who was later identified as [redacted]. The female in the driver seat was a witness of the sexual assault and was identified as [redacted]. The suspect in the sexual assault was identified Elias Huizar (12/07/1984). I was informed [redacted] was Elias's girlfriend and they had a child together that is nine months old.

I was informed that [redacted] and Elias live together at 2507 S Highlands Blvd and [redacted] was friend that was staying the night at the location. I was told [redacted] had witness [redacted] asleep in the bed with her pants down and Elias was "eating [redacted] out." I was informed that Elias also had his pants down and was confronted by [redacted], and child left the location in Elias's truck due to not being able to find her car key and left the location. She drove to the Cougar café located at 10806 Kennedy Rd, Benton City, WA and Elias had followed them to the located. [redacted] then contacted the Deputies that were across the street and Elias had left the location traveling east on Kennedy Rd towards West Richland.

I contacted [redacted] in the driver seat of the vehicle to get a statement from her. [redacted] stated the following; her friend, [redacted] was staying at Elias and her residence located at 2507 S Highland Blvd. All three had been drinking heavily. [redacted] had started to get sick and laid down in the guest bedroom. They laid in the guest bedroom because [redacted] was througning up. They both fell asleep in the guest bedroom. [redacted] woke up and witnessed [redacted] pants down exposing her vagina while she was asleep and stated that Elias was "eating her out." Elias's pants were also down, and she could see his exposed butt. [redacted] confronted Elias, he appeared to be moving his upper body towards [redacted] upper body possibly going to insert his penis into [redacted] vagina. She then confronted Elias and he had left the room.

[redacted] gathered her child and [redacted] before leaving the residence. [redacted] was unable to find her keys but located the keys to Elias GMC Canyon. [redacted] was unable to locate her phone as well and had grabbed Elias's phone. While outside the residence, Elias attempted to prevent them from leaving the residence.

she saw a neighbor and screamed for help but the neighbor went inside their residence. , and child left the location and parked at the Cougar Café in Benton City, WA when Elias arrived at the Cougar Café. drove across the street to the deputies and Elias left the location.

While at the location, Elias used phone to call his phone that had possession of to attempt contact with her multiple times.

informed me that was still wearing the same clothes that she was wearing at the time of the incident.

informed me that nobody else was in the residence. While talking with , she informed me that Elias did have guns inside the residence and informed me the Elias would not go to jail.

While speaking with them, and appeared to be distraught and both were crying. and both appeared to be under the influence of alcohol. Medics were requested to check on and

Deputy Griffin informed me that mentioned that she had woken up to Elias above her. No further information was obtained from . Please see Deputy Griffins supplemental report for further information on her involvement per this case.

While investigation, Sgt Armitage advised that the garage door of the residence of 2507 S Highlands Blvd had opened and closed. More units were requested for containment on the house.

I was requested by Sgt Armitage to respond to the location and apply for a search warrant for the residence. At 0403 hours Judge Petersen informed me that my search warrant was approved and gave me his permission to affix his name to the search warrant.

Officer Suarez made contact with [REDACTED] and informed me that [REDACTED] (01/13/2000) had arrived home at her residence around 0020 hours on 02/03/2024 and witnesses [REDACTED] and Elias arguing outside the residence. I was informed that Officer Suarez obtained ring doorbell footage from the residence. Please see attached video for further information on Ring Door bell footage.

At 0454 hours Elias was placed under arrest and placed into the backseat of Officer Suarez's patrol vehicle. Officer Suarez informed me that Elias requested to speak with an attorney. I completed a 72 hour hold for Elias and emailed it to the Benton County Jail. Officer Suarez transported Elias to the Benton County Jail and booked him on the 72 hour hold.

I was informed by arresting Officers that Elias was located inside the laundry room in the residence and there was a load of laundry placed into washer that was running.

Deputy Griffin informed me that [REDACTED] had red cotton Victoria secret panties with Victoria secret on them with white lettering on before the incident and she no longer had them on. I was informed that the red Victoria secret panties were possibly located inside the residence.

An amended search warrant was applied for and at 0607 hours Judge Petersen informed me that my amended search warrant was approved, and I was given permission to affix Judge Petersen's name to the search warrant.

The amended search warrant was provided to the oncoming patrol shift to serve on the residence. Please see attached supplemental reports for further information on execution of the search warrant.

The following is a written summary of the events described. It does not contain all comments made during the event, the facts, or circumstances relevant to this investigation, nor does it necessarily reflect the chronology of the event. All statements or interviews have been paraphrased in this report unless quotation marks are used. Verbatim statements can be obtained by watching my body worn camera footage.

On 02/03/2024 at approximately 0041 hours, Benton County Deputies advised they were being contacted by two across from Cougar Café in Benton City. The females stated an incident occurred in West Richland involving them and one of the girls' boyfriends who was last seen driving a Kia Optima back towards West Richland. After deputies talked to the females it was determined the 16-year-old female, had been raped by the male, Elias Huizar. The other female, who is 17 years old advised she witnessed the incident. and Elias have a 7-month-old baby together and the three of them live together at Elias' residence located at 2507 South Highlands in West Richland where the rape occurred.

Officer Garrard drove to Benton City to contact the females and I drove to the S Highlands address to see if the Kia Elias was driving was at his residence. I passed the residence, and I didn't see a vehicle in the driveway, and I couldn't see any lights inside. I parked down the roadway facing northbound on S. Highlands.

I was advised by Officer Garrard that was being uncooperative, and she was declining to go to the hospital. I was told both females were intoxicated. Officer Garrard and Deputy Griffin were attempting to get ahold of the parents for the females. I was also told that Elias used to be an officer for Yakima PD, and he

was a School Resource Officer prior to him resigning. I also learned [redacted] and [redacted] are from Yakima. I asked Officer Garrard why it was rape and he stated that [redacted], [redacted], and Elias were all drinking at the house. [redacted] and [redacted] fell asleep on the bed in the spare bedroom. [redacted] woke as she wasn't feeling well to see [redacted] passed out on the bed with her pants pulled down exposing her vagina and Elias was "eating her out" while Elias also had his pants pulled down.

At around 0147 hours, I called Commander Kelly and advised him of the situation, as we were talking, I observed the garage door open and a male figure exited, looked around then went back in the garage and closed the garage door.

I advised dispatch and requested additional units. When additional units arrived, we were able to surround the house and place a West Richland patrol vehicle in front of the garage door. We confirmed the Kia was inside the garage by looking through the garage window. On duty SWAT personnel also arrived to assist.

I had Officer Garrard respond to my location and Deputy Griffin remained with the females. I had Officer Garrard being a Search warrant for Elias and for the spare bed bedding. I began to hail Elias using my patrol vehicles megaphone and I called him using the cell phone number I was provided. I didn't for on and off for an hour with no response inside. I received a call from [redacted] who stated his girlfriend [redacted] has been talking to Elias. Elias told her he was scared. [redacted] stated Elias owned an assault rifle, Glock 40 and a 22 handgun. I told [redacted] that if they spoke to Elias again to have him call me or step outside.

Permission was granted to have SWAT to deploy a flash bang outside the front of the home to see if we could get a response from Elias, but he still wouldn't call or comply with our verbal commands.

I completed the threat matrix which totaled 36 points. Additional SWAT personnel arrived, and the Warrant was approved.

At around 0450 hours, SWAT personnel approached the front door and forced entry through the front door and did a limited penetration. They contacted Elias who was taken into custody without incident. Elias was searched and placed into the rear of Officer Suarez's patrol vehicle. Officer Suarez transported Elias to the

Benton County Jail where he was booked for Rape 2nd degree.

Day shift officers executed the rest of the warrant.

On 2-4-2024 at around 1830 hours, [redacted] called and advised me [redacted] had been receiving calls and text messages from [redacted] telling her not to say anything and Elias had also called [redacted] advising the same thing. [redacted] then texted me seven screen shoots of a conversation between [redacted] and [redacted] which I have uploaded into evidence.com

This is a summary of this contact. This report has paraphrased conversations and does not include the exact sequencing of events and/or all statements verbatim. For full details, see the AXON body camera footage uploaded with the corresponding West Richland Police Department case number 24-001179.

On 02/03/2024, I, Officer Roman Kilinkaridis, was working in my fully marked patrol vehicle for the West Richland Police Department located in West Richland, WA. At approximately 0500 hours, I was dispatched to assist officers with the execution of a search warrant at 2507 S Highlands Blvd. in West Richland. To be noted, the search warrant was approved by a Superior Court Judge, David L Petersen.

At approximately 0625 hours, officers (Sgt Long, Officer Suarez, and I) started the execution of the search warrant. I was assigned to be the search officer. I activated my camera during the search warrant execution. I begin by searching the garage. Nothing significant was found there besides a black 2016 Kia Optima (WA LIC BJJ6144), which it was known to be driven by the alleged victim

Officers moved to the laundry room, where I saw a washer with a light on (as the laundry was done cycling recently). We located a red/gray comforter, red bed sheets, and a gray furry blanket inside the washer. The red and gray comforter had white stains (possibly bodily fluids). To be noted the items from the washer were still wet. I checked the dryer, and the clothing inside was at a regular temperature (it did not appear to be warm as it had dried recently). See photos for details. We collected the wet bedding for evidence. We were in search of the victim's Victoria's

Secret underwear.

Next to the laundry room, I searched a utility/storage room and located a rifle (Colt Serial #LE349779). The rifle was taken for safekeeping due to a door not being secured at the residence. Officers moved to the bedroom to continue executing the search warrant.

In the guest bedroom, officers located red pillowcases similar to what was found in the washing machine. The two red pillowcases and white mattress cover were collected for evidence.

In the master bedroom (with a bathroom), officers located cell phone (iPhone with pink covert) on the dresser's top drawer. In the middle drawer, we found a pair of red Victoria's Secret underwear in an underwear drawer. Under the mattress, we located a loaded Glock 23 pistol (.40 caliber). Under the pillow, I observed an envelope with a large amount of cash (later entered for safekeeping).

Due to the residence being unsecured with a broken front door, we elected to collect several items for safekeeping: \$15,260 cash (149 X \$100, 4 X \$50, 8 X \$20), Colt Rifle (Serial Number #LE349779), two loaded rifle magazines, Glock 23 pistol with loaded magazine (Serial #AKV430US).

At approximately 0850 hours, we completed the search warrant and left copies of the search warrant, evidence log, and safekeeping property receipt on the kitchen counter. We attempted to secure (could open with a hard push) the front door and left through the garage door.

This report is intended to be a summary of events that occurred under West Richland Police Department case number 24-0001179. This report has paraphrased conversations and does not include exact sequencing of events. For exact sequencing and statements please refer to the recording of this event by my body worn camera, as it was recorded during this incident.

On February 3rd, 2024, at approximately 0235 hours, I was requested to respond to 2507 S. Highlands Blvd, West Richland, WA for a barricaded subject who was wanted for the suspicion of rape 2nd degree. I responded in my marked patrol vehicle in full uniform.

On arrival, I was briefed that there was probable cause to arrest Elias Huizer (DOB 12/07/1984) for Rape 2nd degree and he was barricaded inside the above residence. I was advised that Elias was a former police officer and that he has access to weapons. I was directed to move my patrol vehicle in front of the garage to prevent Elias from fleeing the residence in a black Kia Sedan which was parked inside the garage.

I moved my patrol vehicle in front of the garage and activated my emergency lights. Furthermore, stop sticks were staged near my patrol vehicle in case Elias was able to successfully ram or move my patrol vehicle out of the way to flee the scene.

After staging my patrol vehicle in front of the garage, I assisted with securing a perimeter on the 1 and 4 corner of the residence for a couple of hours. During the standoff, I contacted the neighbor's across the street located at [REDACTED]. I contacted [REDACTED] Idnty wit/vic (DOB 01/13/2000) and her husband. [REDACTED] Idnty wit/vic advised she works at the local hospital as a surgical tech and she got home at 0019 hours. [REDACTED] Idnty said she observed a verbal domestic between Elias and the "girl" who lives there. [REDACTED] Idnty said she heard the girl yell at Elias "get the heck away from me" and then take off in Elias's black pickup truck. [REDACTED] Idnty and her husband showed me Ring doorbell camera of [REDACTED] Idnty running inside the residence because she was frightened by the yelling. They provided me with Ring door bell footage which was uploaded to evidence.com. In the video, I could hear yelling but couldn't make out what was being said.

At approximately 0454 hours, on duty Regional SWAT team made force entry into the residence after an approved search warrant and took Elias Huizer into custody without incident. Elias was transferred to me where I searched him incident to arrest and then placed him in the back of my patrol vehicle. Nothing of evidentiary value was located. I read Elias his constitutional rights from my department issued Miranda Card. Elias understood his rights and advised he wanted to speak to an attorney before answering any questions.

I transported Elias to Benton County Jail. While enroute, Elias asked me where his pickup truck was. I asked him which pickup truck was he referring to. Elias said he wanted to know where his GMC Canyon was. I told him that I didn't know the answer.

Elias was booked into Benton County Jail for the charge of Rape 2nd degree. I seized Elias's clothing and shoes for evidence. These were later entered into evidence.

At approximately 0625 hours, I assisted with executing an approved search warrant at 2507 South Highlands Blvd with Sgt. Long and Ofc. Kilinkaridis. Prior to searching, I was tasked with photographing the inside and outside the residence. See uploaded pictures on Evidence.com for details. When entering the residence, I observed the front door was broken due to forced entry. The door jam and framing was tore apart and there

was pieces of wood on the floor. The front door was no longer able to be fully secured. While taking photos, I noticed there were many family photos with the witness, (17YO), and the suspect, Elias Huizer (39YO), while holding their young baby son. I also noted there was an ultrasound photo belonging to () when she was 35 weeks into her pregnancy posted near the front door. The ultrasound picture depicted an expected due date of (04/07/2023) and the ultrasound photo was taken on (03/03/2023). According to a reverse due date calculator, () conceived this baby mid July, 2022 while she was only 15 years old.

Also, while photographing the residence, we noticed that the washing machine appeared to have just finished a washing cycle and there were comforters and sheets inside. Then, in the garbage can under the sink there were empty bottles of alcohol, and red plastic shot glasses. Inside the microwave and on the kitchen counter there was Chinese food to include orange chicken and rice. In the bathroom in the hallway there was a garbage can full of napkins covered in puke. The napkins were orange and contained rice. It is presumed that someone puked up the Chinese food after consuming alcohol and the napkins were used to clean up the mess.

After taking photos of the residence, we began searching the residence for evidence for the crime of rape 2nd degree. We started in the laundry room where we recovered a red/gray comforter, red bed sheets and a gray furry blanket out of the washing machine. The red and gray comforter had apparent puke stains and other bio matter. See photos for details. We collected the wet bedding for evidence. We were in search of the victim's Victoria secret underwear. While searching the laundry room, I found a backpack with many of Elias's police documents from the Yakima Police department to include a school ID while he was a student resource officer for Franklin Middle School. In the utility room next to laundry room we saw a duty patrol rifle (Colt Serial #LE349779). In the garage, there was a black 2016 Kia Optima (WA LIC BJJ6144) registered to #23-REDACTION. It was late learned that the witness, () normally drives this vehicle.

We searched the first "guest" bedroom in the hallway (Spiderman Room with spiderman curtains). Inside this bedroom there was a bed that had red pillow cases similar to what was found in the washing machine. The two red pillow cases and white mattress cover were collected for evidence. It is believed this is where the crime occurred and where the victim was vomiting.

In the master bedroom with its own bathroom we located () cell phone (Iphone with Pink Spek phone cover) on the top drawer of the dresser. In the middle drawer, we found a pair of red Victoria secret underwear in an underwear drawer. Under the mattress we located a loaded Glock 23 pistol (.40 caliber) and a large amount of cash under the pillow.

Due to the residence being unsecured with a broken front door, we elected to collect several items for safekeeping:

- \$15,260 cash (149 X \$100, 4 X \$50, 8 X \$20)
- Colt Rifle (Serial Number #LE349779)
- 2 loaded rifle magazines
- Glock 23 pistol with loaded magazine (Serial #AKV430US)

At approximately 0852 hours, we completed the search warrant and left copies of the search warrant, evidence log, and safekeeping property receipt on the kitchen counter. We secured the front door as best as possible and left through the garage door.

All evidence and property were entered into the West Richland evidence lockers, evidence air drying machine, and cell phone evidence lockers. Evidence Tech Thornburn assisted with placing the wet/damp evidence into the evidence air.

This report is intended to be a summary of events that occurred under West Richland Police Department case number 24-0001179. This report has paraphrased conversations and does not include exact sequencing of events. For exact sequencing and statements please refer to the recording of this event by my body worn camera, as it was recorded during this incident.

On February 3rd, 2024, at approximately 0440 hours, Commander Kelly advised me to respond to 2507 S. Highlands Blvd. because a rape suspect, later identified as Elias Huizer, was currently barricaded inside the residence. I responded in my marked patrol vehicle in full uniform.

At 0450 hours, while in route to the location, I heard on-scene officers advised they had the male in custody. I arrived on scene and spoke with command staff, who advised the oncoming dayshift officers -myself, Officer Suarez, and Officer Kilinkaridis - would be executing a search warrant on the residence at 2507 S. Highlands Blvd. for evidence of the crime of Rape in the Second Degree.

Officer Suarez took photographs and assisted with the of the residence. Officer Kilinkaridis also assisted with the search of the residence. I oversaw the evidence log and assisted with searching the residence.

The search warrant execution began at 0625 hours.

As we entered the residence through the front door, I noted significant damage to the deadbolt locking mechanism. There did not appear to be a secondary lock on the door.

While searching the northmost (closest to the living room), children's room, I located a mattress on the floor which had a red fitted bedsheet and pillows covered with red pillowcases consistent with the sheet found in the dryer. The sheet appeared to have bodily fluids on it. The red fitted sheet, three red pillowcases, and the mattress cover located under the fitted sheet were also taken for evidence.

While searching the master bedroom (southwest corner), I located a pair of female's red Victoria Secret underwear inside the top middle dresser drawer, which contained other female garments. The underwear was red with a light/diamond print lettering on it. The underwear was collected because it was very similar to what the victim said she was wearing prior to the alleged assault.

All other items collected were located by Officer Suarez and Officer Kilinkaridis. Please see their supplemental reports and the On-Site Evidence Log for a full list of evidence collected.

The items collected were bagged and transferred to the West Richland Police Department, where they were entered into Evidence.

The search warrant concluded at 0852 hours.

Due to the inability to fully secure the front door, five additional items were taken for safekeeping. An M4 Law Enforcement rifle, two loaded AR magazines, a loaded .40 caliber Glock handgun with an extended magazine, and \$15260.00 in cash. Due to the large amount of cash, I observed Officer Suarez count the cash while his camera was activated. The bill denomination was \$14,900 in one-hundred bills, \$200 in fifty-dollar

bills, and \$160 in twenty-dollar bills. These items were transferred to the police station where they were also entered into Evidence for safekeeping. See Officer Suarez's report for full details.

On 2/3/2024 at approximately 0230 hours, I received a phone call from Commander Coates regarding a recent Rape that occurred in West Richland at the residence located at 2507 S. Highlands Blvd.

I arrived at the West Richland Police Department and started reviewing the case. I learned on the morning of February 3, 2024, at approximately 0041 hours Officers were contacted by the witness, [redacted] with dob [redacted] and the victim [redacted]

According to the Officers reports, [redacted] and [redacted] were both "Hysterically crying" when [redacted] drove up to Deputies in Benton City to report the crime of Rape. The reports indicate [redacted] arrived with [redacted] in the passenger seat and an infant in the back seat. [redacted] informed Officers her child identified as [redacted] with dob [redacted] 9 months old and the child is from Elias. Officer's reports also indicate the driver and passenger appeared to be intoxicated. [redacted] due to the infants age, will hereafter be referred to as [redacted]

[redacted] explained to officers she had her best friend [redacted] over to her residence located at 2507 S. Highlands Blvd. with her, [redacted] boyfriend Elias. The suspect was identified as Elias Huizar with dob 12/07/1984. Once at the location, all parties began consuming alcoholic beverages. This continued throughout the night until [redacted] became intoxicated to the point of vomiting. [redacted] was then taken to a spare bedroom within the residence by [redacted] who also laid down in the same bed and fell asleep. Due to

also being very intoxicated, she fell asleep beside

Reports indicate stated she awoke because her stomach hurt and noticed Elias above and "eating her out" and he was "trying to have sex with her." said Elias pants were down and he had pulled pants off. Note: I interviewed on 02/3/2024 and during that interview, said she awoke to find she did not have any clothing on below the waist and did not have blankets covering her.

told officers she also awoke to see Elias on top of her. said she was wearing red "Victoria secret" underwear and pink pajama bottoms that night.

reported Elias was apologizing and said it would never happen again and stated, "I know he didn't rape her but he was trying to."

said she attempted to leave with and , but when she opened the garage door Elias would close it.

Reports indicate , left the residence with Elis phone as he had taken hers. While was giving her statement to officers, Elias continued to try and call her using her phone. Note: During the interview with , she informed me she was also receiving calls from Elias.

On 2/5/2024 I returned a missed phone call from and it was answered by a female who identified herself as . I was told the number belongs to her mother and she requested to receive her phone back as it was taken by the police. I advised her we would need to keep her phone for a while longer due to the investigation. I asked if she had spoken with Elias after giving her statement to the officers and she said she had. said Elias was telling her to tell the police he was not home. said she has an iPhone 12 Chrome and is a cream color with # and a passcode of . said Elias also has an iPhone, possibly a 12 Chrome, and a black case. was unable to recall what Elias phone number was but stated it ended in . I checked TLO, a website for LE and found #

At 1226 hours, I spoke with the evidence tech who removed the phone from the secured locker, and I used the passcode gave to me to unlock the phone. I then removed airplane mode from the phone and called the phone number listed above. The phone started ringing and showed my work cell number. After verifying this was the correct number, the phone was placed back into airplane mode and placed within the faraday bag. The bag was placed back into the same secure locker and secured at 1230 hours by the evidence technician.

Elias shows a birth date of 12/07/1984, currently 39 years of age; shows a birth date of , currently 17 years of age and was born 9 months old. Given the average length of human gestation is 280 days or 40 weeks, and being born on , this would show was possibly conceived in the early month of July 2022. This date is four months prior to 16th birthday making her 15 years of age when she was impregnated by Elias who would be 37 years of age at that time. This shows a crime of RCW 9A.44.079 Rape of a child in the 3rd when the child is at least 14 ears old but less than 16 and the perp is at least forty-eight months older than the victim.
